The IRS debt at St. Brigid Parish has been paid in full! From this point on, all monies collected in our Debt Collections will go directly to our Diocesan Debt.

St. Brigid

Diocesan Debt \$386,727.81 - \$1,318.51 (March Payment) = \$385,409.30 - \$659.26 (Diocesan Write Off) = \$384,750.04

Our Lady of the Assumption

Diocesan Debt \$47,924.67 - \$2,676.00 (March Payment) = \$45,248.67 - \$1,338.00 (Diocesan Write Off) = \$43,910.67

DID YOU KNOW???

At our current rate of giving (Debt Collection) it will take us approximately 11 years to pay off our St. Brigid Debt and approximately 3 years to pay off Assumption's debt to the Diocese.

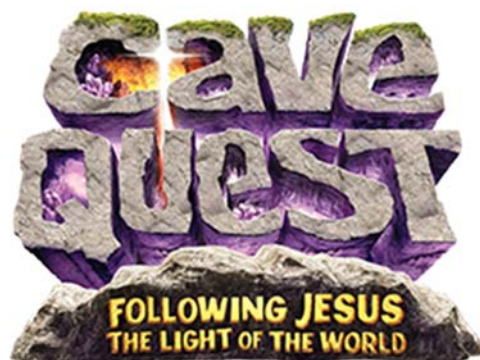

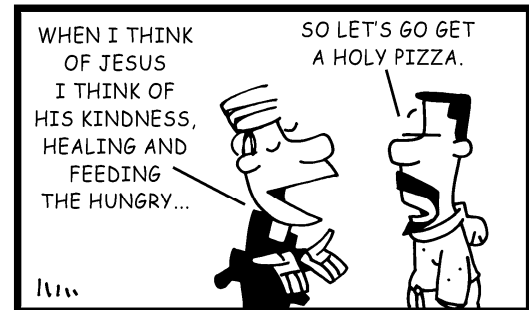
