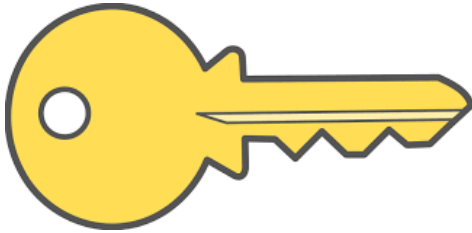

For years and years, the Sisters of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary taught hundreds of children who passed through the doors of Assumption School. These fine teachers and dedicated Religious women lived in the convent at 15 Grove Street. Nowadays, the staff at the school is all lay women and men and no Sisters teach in the school nor have any lived in the convent for a long time. Even our beloved Sr. Jeanne lives in an apartment in town on Elm Street.

So, if the building is no longer home to any Sisters, should we keep referring to the structure standing at 15 Grove Street as the convent? For the past couple of years and for at least the next three years, the property has been rented to Providence College as housing for their P.A.C.T. Program which stands for Providence Alliance for Catholic Teachers. Young teachers who have gone through their undergraduate studies at Providence College come to Worcester to teach in various Catholic schools in the area, while residing in our Grove Street property.

Recently, a suggestion was made to rename this building MARY'S HOUSE. It was felt this name would honor Mary, the patroness of Our Lady of the Assumption Parish and the Assumption School, while also testifying to the influence of the Sisters of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, and now, invoke her protection as the Seat of Wisdom and Mother of the Universal Church of the young teachers who live in her house and teach her children.

What do you think? We'd appreciate hearing your thoughts and ideas about this proposal before any final decision would be made. Just jot down your ideas on the tear-off and drop it in the collection basket.

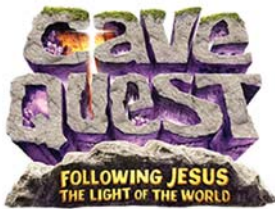
