Be Merciful like the Father
Celebrating the Jubilee Year of Mercy

Pope Francis tells us that “we all need to go apart, to ascend the mountain in a space of silence, to find ourselves and to better perceive the voice of the Lord in our hearts. This we do in prayer.

We cannot, however, stay there. Encounter with God in prayer inspires us anew to ‘descend the mountain’ and return to the plain where we meet many brothers and sisters weighed down by fatigue, sickness, poverty - both material and spiritual.”

At one time or another, all of us have seen the face of a person light up by good news or a moment of deep joy and real happiness. One day, Jesus’ face too lit up, became radiant and was totally transformed by the realization of the Father’s love for him and that his mission and suffering would not be in vain because through it he would become the ‘door of mercy’ and bring eternal life to all.

The encounter in today’s gospel is not only for Jesus and the disciples that accompanied him but also for ourselves. It is about encounters with our merciful God. These encounters happen to people who are struggling with doubt, sorrow, and confusion. It happens to those who are afraid and seem to walk in the dark. Yet, experiencing God’s merciful presence with us can totally change and transform us. Prayer readies our heart and opens us to change.

As we journey through prayer this Lent, may we also know moments when our faces light up with deep joy and happiness, and moments when we bring this deep radiance to the faces and hearts of those around us.

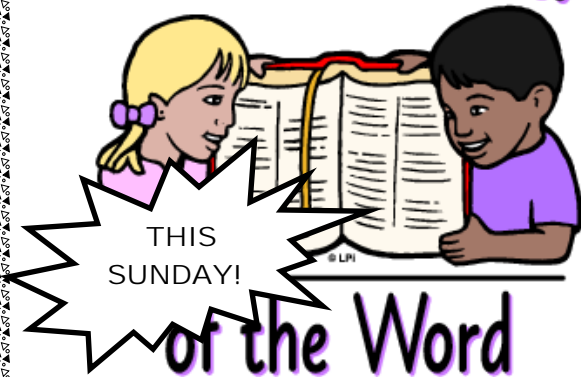

Rice Bowls can be found at the entrances of both churches and should be returned on Palm Sunday weekend.

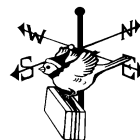


PRIESTHOOD DISCERNMENT RETREAT

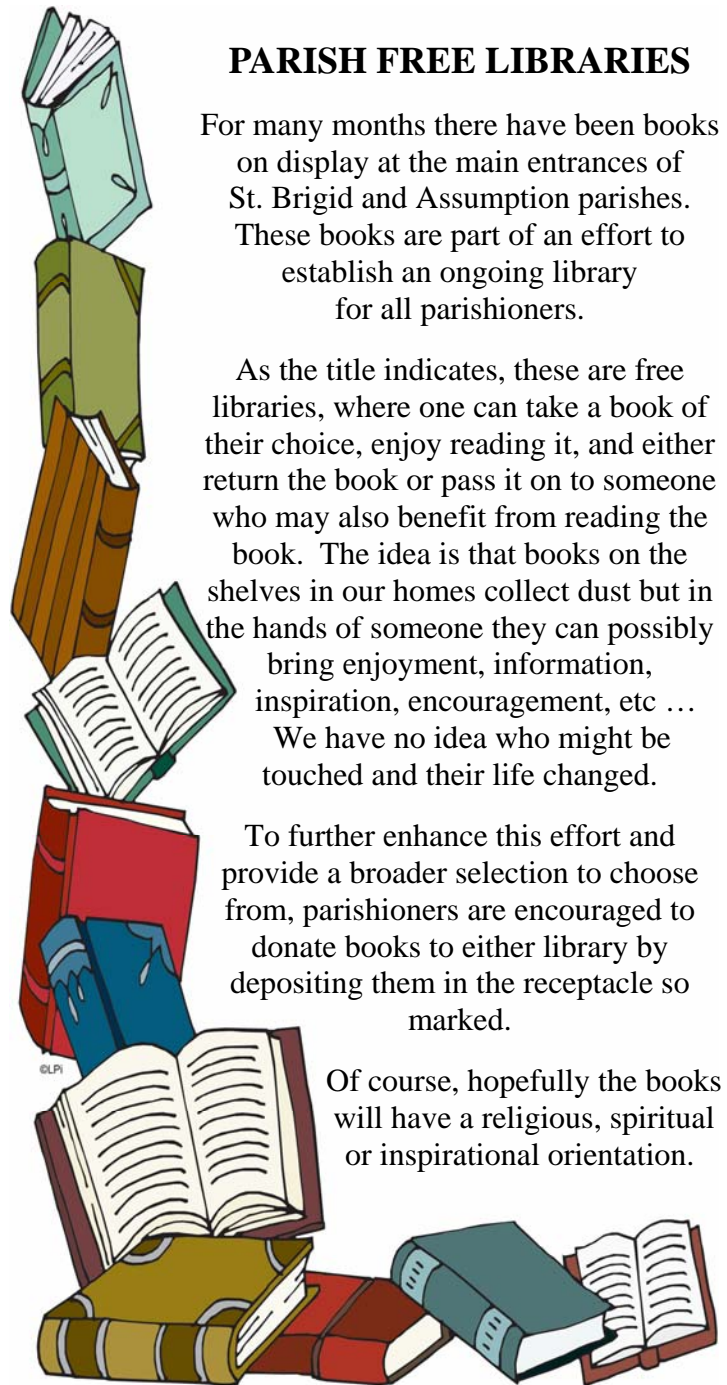
PARISH FREE LIBRARIES
