McKoul Electric recently replaced the outside lights around St. Brigid Parish with LED lights. This was completed at a projected cost of \$5,357.61 Through a National Grid incentive, National Grid will pay \$2,741.20 of the cost, leaving our contribution at \$2,616.41. Our estimated annual savings in dollars is \$789.47. In less than 3 1/2 years we will recoup our expenses and continue to save on our monthly electric bills.

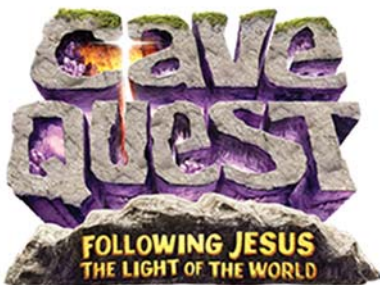

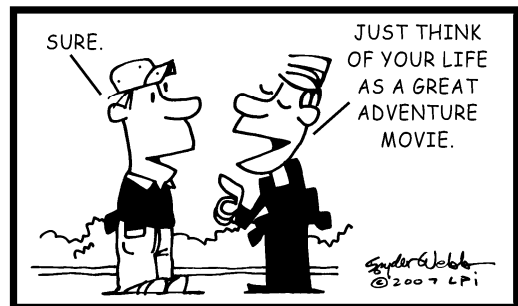
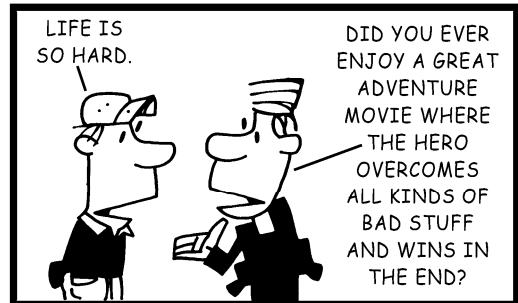
